AMERICAN HISTORY

The Age of anxiety (1952-1958)

The American chronicles CD-ROM series features newsreel clips of events that occurred before, during and after World War II. These fully-interactive programs let users move around the world with a click of the mouse. From scenes of the Depression and war-torn Europe to segments on the trials at Nuremberg and the election of President John F. Kennedy, each program highlights the leaders, triumphs and tragedies of a specific time in history. Eisenhower is elected the first Republican president in twenty years, the Korean War ends, Elizabeth II becomes England's eighth queen, Edmund Hillary conquers Mr. Everest; Stalin dies, leaving Khrushchev to develop "good-guy diplomacy": the U.S. and Russia begin the arms race, China takes Taiwan's small islands near the mainland; the U.S. gives massive military support to Chiang Kai-shek in his attempts to retake the Chinese mainland; Castro's rebels challenge Batista in Cuba; and Vice President Nixon is assaulted by angry mobs while on a good-will tour of Venezuela. American Decades

It explores 20th century U.S. history in a manner that encourages the users to examine the social, political, and cultural history in a theme-based context. It features more than 1000 biographical entries, approximately 1500 original overview and subject-specific essays, a navigable timeline that features both world and national events, over 100 primary documents including news articles and much more. [2]

American History

Explores American history from the time of the Vikings to today. Covers 400 major events in the evolution of the country, including biographies of presidents and first ladies. [3]

American History and Culture

This CD-ROM contains the full text of the Dictionary of American History (7 vols, 1976) and the Dictionary of American History Supplement (2vols, 1996). The Presidents A Reference History Second Edition (1 vol., 1996). Encyclopedia of American Social History (3 vols, 1993 with updates through 1997), and Dictionary of American biography Supplements Nine (1 vol, 1994) and Ten (1 vol. 1995) In addition, the Scribner editors have added a key events time line and selected more than 600 photographs and more than fifty primary source documents to illumine the text. The American Revolution

This interactive multimedia program allows users to examine the Revolution from two distinct perspectives; that of the colonies and that of England. The program features substantial text, including contemporary documents, pre- and post-viewing tests, activities, a chronology, and a bibliography. Within three sections--Before the War, War, and Aftermath--topics include the Seven-Year's War, Parliamentary Acts, Boston Massacre, British colonial policy, the Continental Congresses, Shay's Rebellion, and much more. [4]

Antebellum: America 1820-1860

This program explores the rapid Westward expansion of the United States. Follow the great explorers, probe the Oregon Trail, and find gold in California. The CD-ROM covers the Mexican-American War, birth of the railroads, the Age of Jackson, and the widening gulf between North and South. Special sections cover the economy, people and arts of the period. [6]

The Civil War

This disc covers the Civil War, one of most pivotal events in the evolution of the United States. Users can examine primary source documents on the causes leading up to the war, the impact on the homefront, the lives of ordinary soldiers, and the crucial events of the Reconstruction. It also features photographs, images, drawings, and battle maps, which explain military milestones. [39]

Discovering U.S. History

Thousands of essays on people, places, time periods, and events in U.S. History will draw you into this title. Color illustrations and reproductions of original documents (Declaration of Independence and Treaty of Versailles) will keep you clicking away. [38]

Franklin Delano Roosevelt

He changed the course of history like no other president before or since. He was a uniquely hero, a strong man in a wheelchair, an aristocrat with the common touch, a president in desperate times. Explore the life and legacy of Franklin Delano Roosevelt, whose four unprecedented terms spanned the Great Depression and World War II. [37]

The Great Depression and the New Deal

The history of this momentous time is treated not only in the context of the global economy of the 1930s, but also of economic circumstances in 1990s America. The Federal Writers Project and Federal Art Project, constitutional crises, economics and the coming of global war are examined from personal and public perspectives, letters, literature, graphic arts and music bring the Great Depression into focus on an immediate level. Landmark Documents in American History

Over 1,000 full-text documents chart nearly 500 years of American history, included are 200 biographies, 200 photographs and illustrations, hypertext search capability, as well as video and sound clips (on Windows, version only). Introductions provide the historical context and explain the significance of each landmark document. Search by subject, period, year, historical figure, and document title simultaneously. Documents include Supreme Court decisions, political party platforms, and letters. [35]

National Geographic

A monthly richly illustrated magazine of geography and allied subjects--travel, discovery, exploration and scientific research--in various parts of the world and in various cultures. (collection 1888 to 1990)

The Sixties, 1960-70

The 60's transports you back to the period that transformed the face of contemporary America, a decade famous for unprecedented political, cultural, social, and technological turmoil. Watch the assassinations of JFK and RFK; listen to the countdown for the first flight to the moon; cheer the Beatles as they storm America. Hundreds of photos, videos and original source documents provide unparalleled insight into this tumultuous era. [99]

U.S. History: Foreign Policy (1788-1933)

Traces the development of the United States from a proponent of isolationism to a policy of imperialism and a leader in world affairs. It also includes excerpts from speeches of Woodrow Wilson, Franklin Roosevelt, Harry Truman and much more. [13]

U.S. History: Foreign Policy (1933-1963)

Presents the development of America's foreign policy from the Great Depression to the Kennedy years. It covers the US's isolationism during the depression, the return to world leadership during WW II and the cold war [68]

U.S. History: Jacksonian Democracy

Contains information on the political and social developments of the Jacksonian age. It also covers Jackson's life from plantation owner to president of the United States [69]

U.S. History: Reconstruction

Contains information on the political and social condition of the U.S. during the rebuilding of the nation following the Civil War. It explores the efforts of Freed slaves and their Republican supporters as well as the South's program of intimidation and complicated legal codes to suppress the rights of blacks [70]

U.S. History: Social Reform Movements

Covers social reform movements in the United States, from Abolitionists in the 1800's to unionism and welfare reforms of the 1930's. [71]

U.S. History: U.S. Government (1783-1865)

Contains information on the first 100 years of the United States existence. It covers the creation of the Constitution, Whiskey Rebellion, the War of 1812 and the Civil War. [72]

U.S. History: U.S. Government (1866-1977)

Contains information on the development of the United States following the Civil War. It covers issues associated with industrialization, immigration, migration, and poverty. [67]

The Life of Abraham Lincoln

The work here offered was begun in 1894 at the suggestion of Mr. S. S. McClure and Mr. J.S. Philips, editors of "McClure's Magazine" Their desire was to add to our knowledge of Abraham Lincoln by collecting and preserving the reminiscences of such of his contemporaries as were then

living. To facilitate the work, all persons possessing or knowing of Lincoln were asked through the magazine to communicate with the editor. The author wrote thousands of letters and traveled thousands of miles collecting the material. It is Lincoln the man, as seen by his fellows and revealed by his own acts and words that the author has tried to picture. [87]

War in Vietnam

America's premier broadcast and print news organizations combine for a comprehensive look back at the war in Vietnam. CBS brought this conflict to the living rooms of America, and the New York Times analyzed the policies and personalities that drove this country deeper into war and brought conflict to the nation's streets and schools. The power of interactive multimedia puts all this information at your fingertips. [34]

Westward Expansion

This disc provides easy access to four centuries of Western history from the explorations of Columbus to the West at the turn of the 19th Century. It features frontier America, its challenges, ruggedness, and resources, through the eyes of the explorer, missionaries, cowboys, and pioneers who ventured west. Themes covered include Early Openings to the West (1500-1700). The Gold Rush and Early Mining Towns, The West in Art, Literature and Pop Culture and Changing Views of the West. [64]

AMERICAN LITERATURE

American Poetry: The Nineteenth Century

This disk combines The Library of America's two-volume collection into a single definitive anthology. This collection of over 1000 poems by nearly 150 poets reveals the full beauty and diversity of the poetic tradition of the United States. The anthology extends chronologically from the classical couplets of Philip Freneau through the pioneering free verse of Walt Whitman to the modernist stirrings of Stephen Crane. [65]

The History of American literature

A multimedia literary history of American literature starting from the literature of the Colonies to the 1980's. (4 CDs.) [14 & 15]

The Norton Anthology of African Literature

"This anthology, a major contribution to literary / cultural studies, deeply and richly textures the history and presence of African American writing, speech, folklore, drama, and music. Here's where the Audio Companion is welcome and important and necessary; it textures our understanding in new ways." Building on the editors' view that vernacular expression lives in performance, the original Audio Companion CD has been expanded to a two-CD set; Disc 1, Music, includes vocal and instrumental pieces—from ragtime to Motown. Disc 2, Spoken Word, offers 24 speeches, readings,

and performances, from Booker T. Washington and W. E. B. Du Bois to Amiri Baraka and Rita Dove. [112]

Twayne's U.S. Authors

This reference work offers critical introductions to the lives and works of writers, to the history and influence of literary movements, or the development of literary genres. It includes such authors as James Agee, E.E. Cummings, William Faulkner, Annie Dillard, Garrison Kellor, and more. [16]

Twayne's Women Authors

This comprehensive reference contains the complete text of 135 books on women authors, including novelists, short story writers, poets playwrights, critics, and essayists from the 17th century to the present. It provides complete biographical information and in-depth criticism for each author. [32]

A. Education

College Explorer 2000

College Explorer 2000 on CD-ROM gives students a quick, easy way to identify the features they want in a college and immediately come up with a list of colleges that fit their needs. It also provides summary information about each college and guidance information enhanced with video clips, plus direct link to college web sites and to College Board online. [65]

Peterson's College Database

A full text database containing profiles of the colleges in the U.S. and Canada. It includes information on student enrollment, score ranges and admissions, expenses, housing etc. [33]

U.S. Academic Explorer

The explorer is an interactive guide to study in the United States. This multimedia adventure gives you scores of photographs of academic life in the U.S., video guides to help you navigate through Explorer, fun and easy-to-read text, and interviews with international students. The Explorer answers your most basic questions about studying in the United States and addresses issues ranging from the practical to the personal, including applications and admission requirements, transcripts and testing, academic life, passports and visas, living on-or of-campus. ELT Journal

Contains every article published in ELT Journal from issue 36/1 (October 1981 - 2004). It also includes language features key concepts, and talking shops. It does not contain reviews, correspondence, editorials, announcements, or advertisements.

The material on the CD-ROM appears exactly as it was originally published, in the form of a scanned image of the original text. This ensures that what you see on the screen is exactly what was in the original printed version of the Journal. [61]

Street Atlas USA

This disk will let you view and print out maps right down to the local street address in all 50 states. It may be used with the Phone Search USA CD-ROM to look up a name and then pinpoint the location. [17 & 18]

World Book Encyclopedia

World book 2001 premium editions brings together World Book 2001. The multimedia version of the World book is a reference collection of a depth and breadth to meet the needs of a student learning about a subject as part of research for a class assignment. [106]

GLOBAL ISSUES

Environmental Hypermedia Programs

The Environmental Protection Agency's Region 5 Office in Chicago has collaborated with Purdue University to develop computer-based environmental training programs for several years. 16 programs dealing primarily with agricultural waste disposal and water quality and conservation issues were first offered to the field. [24]

Our war on terror begins with al-Qaida, but it does not end there. It will not end until every terrorist group of global reach has been found, stopped, and defeated.” President George W. Bush. This CD-Rom is a collected official articles and documents published by US government. [110]

U. S. GOVERNMENT AND POLITICS

ACE Project

The administration and cost of elections project are presented in nine primary topic areas, Electoral systems; legislative framework; electoral management; boundary delimitation; Voter education; voter registration; voting operations; parties and candidates; and vote counting. [11]

American Presidency

The American Presidency is an in-depth multimedia presentation of the people, politics, and institutions that have shaped the history of the executive branch of the United States. This unique collection features hundreds of articles drawn from Grolier’s three major encyclopedias, combines with original video and audio recordings, vintage photographs, works, take a few minutes to visit the Presidential Assistant. [29]

The Constitution and Supreme Court

This CD-ROM treats in detail the beginnings of American constitutionalism and the ratification of the Constitution and the Bill of Rights. More than sixty Supreme Court decisions are presented—with majority, concurring and the often-important dissenting opinions. All of them include the justice’s own cross-referencing to other cases. Every case is indexed by its name and by key issues. [41]

Famous American Speeches

Contains more than 3000 speeches with video, audio, and photographs. Each speech includes an introduction. Enables the user to conduct Boolean searches and print or download all media elements. [25]

Historic Supreme Court Decisions, 1999 edition

An electronic Publication of the Legal Information Institute, Cornell Law School.

This edition includes decisions in full text, organized by topic, by justice, and by era. It also includes important rulings from the Court’s most recent term as well as several from earlier years. It also holds biographies and portraits of all justices who have served on the Court. [42]

Nixon

Contains complete trial transcripts, screenplay, original essays, over 15 minutes of Richard Nixon video, more than 700 historic Nixon photos, over 70,000 pages of documents, scenes from Oliver Stone’s film and much more. It also features biographical sketches of 250 influential people in Nixon’s life, a chronology of 1,000 of Nixon’s most impor

tant days, exclusive interviews with experts and Nixon contemporaries. [76]

Origins of the Constitution

This interactive multimedia tutorial enables students to explore the establishment of the United States government. Students see how personalities, philosophies, and political realities contributed to the making of the Constitution. Visuals and narration are highlighted by quotations and thoughts from people of the time. Text files include the Articles of Confederation, the Constitution, the Declaration of independence, Federalist Papers, and the Declaration of Rights. [53]

The Public Diplomacy Query system (PDQ)

The Public Diplomacy Query system (PDQ) is a family of interactive online and CD-ROM databases created by the Library Programs Division of USIA to serve the information needs of USIA/USIS offices around the world. Together these databases provide timely, comprehensive subject access to a wide range of Agency produced and acquired material. The PDQ system is a useful programming and policy research tool as well as a convenient method of retrieving full text of the Wireless File articles and USINFOs. [44 – 52]

United States Code

The consolidated full-text of all 50 titles of the Federal Government’s official compendium of U.S. laws in effect as of January 1994 as well as the Popular Names listing. [54]

U.S. Foreign Affairs

Provides easy access to more than 4,000 official documents featuring the President, Secretary of State, and other senior officials from January 1990. In addition, USFAC includes the full texts of the Department’s Weekly Dispatch, the official record of the U.S. foreign policy; official transcript of State’s Daily Press Briefings, background notes of countries and international organizations. [77 & 82]

The Atlas of U.S. Presidents

The Atlas of U.S. Presidents is broken into six separate sections, each covering a specific subject. Basically on Presidents biographies, election map, facts, first lady information, a historical map, a brief history, and a speech are available for that president. [83]

U.S. SOCIETY AND MULTICULTURAL STUDIES

African American Culture and History

African-American Culture and History on CD-ROM contains the full text of the five volume encyclopedia of African American Culture and History, newly revised and updated for electronic publication. Over 250 articles and many appendices have been revised, and more than 30 new articles have been added. In addition to the 2,300 articles in the Encyclopedia, the CD-ROM includes [105]

The African American Experience

Users can explore African American history from the beginnings of slavery in colonial America, through the post Civil Rights Era of the 1990s. Users can access information on a wide range of topics including African American religions, folklore, family structure, art, literature, music, and more. It also includes photographs, images drawings, journals, letters and audio clips. [7]

African American History: Slavery to Civil Rights

Explores the history of African-American culture and people from early colonial slavery to the 60's protests with specific focus on the paths of noted African-Americans and their rise to leadership. [8]

Amistad

It covers the history of slavery from ancient times and shows the Amistad incident in the context of the trans-Atlantic slave trade, the abolition of slavery and Civil Rights. In addition to the text on screen, further study material and group activities are present as hidden text. [5]

American Indian: A Multimedia Encyclopedia

This multimedia guide through the rich culture and history of the American Indian tribes, legends and treaties, includes over 1,000 photos, maps, sound bytes, major regions and families. It spans more than four centuries and contains details and insight into North American folklore and religion. [9]

The American Indian: CD-ROM

This CD features a wide range of primary sources such as Federal Treaties, School Craft encyclopedia, American State Papers through 1826 and many others. All these sources, present American Indian their history, their life style, their culture, their custom. [10]

The Asian-American Experience

This title amasses a rich array of primary sources to tell the history of Asian Americans from their own perspectives and in their own words. Drawing on the exhaustive research of the Asian American Studies Center at UCLA, it chronicles the Asian-American Experience from pre-historic Asian/North American migrations up to the works of contemporary Asian-American artists and writers. Discovering Multicultural America

Provides text, motion picture video, statistical imagery, and photographs on four major cultural groups: African Americans, Asian Americans, Hispanic Americans, and Native North Americans. Disc offers seven categories of information, which consist of biographies, essays, landmarks, significant documents, timeline, organizations, and complete text periodical articles. Searching capabilities allow the user to conduct custom searches across categories. [43]

The Hispanic-American Experience

Users will witness the role that Spanish-speaking peoples have played in the history of North America and the U.S. as they journey through the hundreds of primary source documents and images. From poems by the indigenous forerunners of today's Central American immigrants to the work of Los Angeles' Chicano graffiti artists, this disc weaves together materials that represent the full range of the Latino experience. [26]

Jazz: Early Jazz Legends

Live through the origins of jazz until 1945 following the actors of this cultural movement who completely changed the history of music, particularly Louis Armstrong, Duke Ellington or Billie Holiday. You will be able to listen some of the most famous jazz pieces of this first part of the century and to see the legends come to life in video clips of performances. [78]

Jazz: Greats

Step inside the world of unforgettable jazz with JAZZ GEATS. The most noteworthy legends of jazz history are performing in a private concert just for you! Explore the roots and influences of the early jazz era. Experience artist performance videos, over 15 jazz tunes, intriguing expert discussions, photographs, comprehensive narrative and more. See the improvisations of Louis Armstrong. Experience Duke Ellington playing Take the "A" Train. Understand the emotion behind Billie Holiday's musical interpretations, including her version of Fine and Mellow. Tap your foot along with Art Tatum's Tea for Two. Gain insight into the improvisational and changing style that makes great jazz so memorable. [84]

Women in America

This disc allows users to discover what life was like for women in America from the 1500s right up to the 1990s. They can explore themes such as native American women, women under slavery, women on the frontier. Women during World War II, Women writers in the 20th Century, and more. It also features a host of primary source materials, images, letters, journals, maps, photographs, drawings, documents, essays, and audio clips of folk songs and speeches. [27]

Women's Rights

This program chronicles the struggle for equality through 650 articles 350 captioned photographs, 21 biographies, 37 audio recordings, narration, and much more. The information is

grouped in 11 categories, the body, power, education, the workplace, family, women's lib, war and peace, image, motherhood and the vote. [102]
